

The Core Values of the Medical Students' Association

Adopted by the governing assembly of the Medical Students' Association on 22 May 2013

Each student who represents the Medical Students' Association (MF) does so in compliance with the present core values both in relation to the Faculty of Medicine and Lund University and in relation to other students.

Values

MF is represented by those working within the association, who are all responsible for taking a stand in favour of the shared values established in the present document.

Everything done in the name of MF is to be based on diversity, solidarity and respect for others, and to assume the equal value of all people. Discrimination or victimisation on the basis of gender, transgender identity or expression, ethnicity, religion or other belief, disability, sexual orientation or age are not accepted. Regardless of circumstances and life situation, all members are to have real opportunities to take part in MF's work.

MF is the body that represents the students on the study programmes in biomedicine, speech and language pathology, audiology and medicine, as well as the students studying on the Master's programme in Public Health, and is thereby the voice of these students towards the Faculty of Medicine and Lund University.

MF strives to make the most of all students' experiences in the association's work. MF's work is to be characterised by openness and the association's organisational structure is to be easily accessible. The formal ways in which individual students can influence and take part in decisions are to be clear and coherent.

All students are to be given the same opportunities for growth and development within the association. MF upholds democratic discussion as a tool for opinion-making and influence.
