§1. Meeting declared open *Cornelia Börjesson Freitag* declared the meeting open.

§4. Selection of adjustment person The board chose *Anna Cederberg* as the adjustment person to approve and adjust the meeting protocol with the chairman and the secretary.

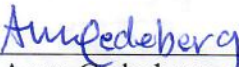
§5. Approval of the previous StorBUR meeting protocol The previous meeting protocol was approved.

§6. Semester round and Reports Master Year 2 – *Thesis course*. There are problems with the information and communication from the course leaders.

Master Year 1 – *Experimental design*. The program and the course are new. Student experience the course as stressful and disorganized. There has been a meeting which has settled some problems and there are new ways to give feedback to teachers on Ortrac. The fact that the purpose of the course is to develop lab skills was not expressed clearly at the beginning of the course.

Year 3 – *Developmental biology and genetics*. The course involves a lot of PBL (almost too much), there are some issues with one tutor and there are too many students in each group. However, it has overall worked better than last semester. There has been a lack of structure in the lectures. PBL is on Zoom while lectures are pre-recorded.

Year 2 – *Molecular cell biology*. The course is completely on campus which is appreciated. PBL is working well and fits well with the course curriculum.

Year 1 – *Cell biology and chemistry*. Students experience the course as fast paced, there is limited time for the topics to sink in, and there are not enough practice questions. Problems with Ortrac are frustrating for both students and teachers. Chemistry and biology are not integrated very well in the course. After two Covid-19 cases, classes were online for only one week, which students think is too short, however, many are happy to be back on campus after online classes. The English in the course is working well and international students feel welcomed.

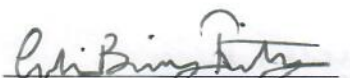
PNM – Regulations for barriers at the beginnings of the semesters are being changed. The minimum credits needed to enter T3, T5 and T6 will be increased, to help students earlier and make sure they can pass the following term. Construction of Forum Medicum is back on schedule despite a late start. The curriculums for T2 of the new programs (both Bachelor and Master) are complete.


BRO – No new meetings. Fall meeting postponed until spring.

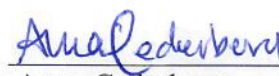
JämU – No meetings currently.

Program directors – Whether courses are on campus or online depends on course leaders, and if the course will be equally good online, then it will be online. It is also important to reply to surveys sent out by the faculty.

International committee – The introduction meeting for the international buddy group went well. Incoming exchange students to LU has decreased due to Covid-19, and all outgoing exchanges from LU are cancelled this semester. Status for exchanges next semester is currently not decided. Applications for non-partner university exchanges fall 2021 will open in November. There have

MHFA

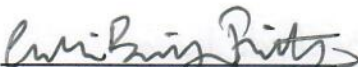

Students in T1 would also rather have the course in English with two mixed groups rather than one in English and one in Swedish.


Vacant post

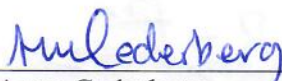

SI budget

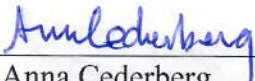

Cornelia Börjesson Freitag declared the meeting closed.

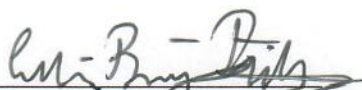
